Malin Hildebrand Karlén is a clinical psychology who works at the National Board of Forensic Medicine, Forensic Psychiatry as a researcher and clinical psychologist, and also at the Department of Psychology, University of Gothenburg as associate professor. Her research areas include: psychiatric co-morbidity among substance dependent patients, decision-making in forensic psychiatric investigations, developmental pathways to aggressive antisocial behavior, and history of psychiatric diagnoses with emphasis on addiction and personality disorders.



Currently, she serves as the Director of CELAM – Centre for Ethics, Law, and Mental Health (https://www.gu.se/en/celam), a collaboration among the Research Groups in Forensic Psychiatry, University of Gothenburg, The National Board of Forensic Medicine, Swedish Prison and Probation Service, The Forensic Psychiatric Clinic, Sahlgrenska University Hospital, the Research Group of Forensic Psychiatry, Lund University, and a group of researchers in Philosophy at the Department of Philosophy, Linguistics and Theory of Science, University of Gothenburg.

CELAM conducts, supports and disseminates research about mental disorders, aggressive behaviour and moral and legalresponsibility in an inter-disciplinary framework. Theultimateaim of CELAM is to run a national centre of excellence for research about mental illness among young violent offenders, to pursue research of high quality in this area and educate personnel who can meet the relevant societal organisations' demands for scientific and clinical knowledge.
